NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

CITY OF TIPP CITY, OHIO, State of Ohio, through its City Manager, will receive sealed proposals for:

1.0 MILLION GALLON ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK

until 10:00 a.m., local time, on January 28, 2010 at the Tipp City Government Center, 260 South Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371. Said proposals will be opened as soon thereafter as the opening can begin. All bids shall be submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Instructions to Bidders.

This project consists of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for the design, fabrication, erection and painting of a 1.0 million gallon elevated water storage tank.

Copies of the Bidding Documents are available at LJB Inc., 3100 Research Blvd., P.O. Box 20246, Kettering, Ohio 45420-0246, where they may be obtained upon payment of One Hundred (\$100.00), for each set of documents, made payable to the LJB Inc., NONE OF WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED. Should the contractor request that the Bidding Documents be mailed to him, there will be an additional charge of \$10.00 to cover regular mail posting or \$20.00 to cover the cost of overnight posting.

Copies of the Specifications and Bidding Documents may be examined at the Dodge Plan Room, 3077 South Kettering Boulevard, Suite 301, Dayton, Ohio 45439 (telephone 937-687-1341) and at the Tipp City Government Center.

Each Bid shall be signed by the full name and business address of each person or company in the same; and SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED by a bid security. Bid security shall be provided in accordance with the requirements of Article 8 of the Instructions to Bidders.

The original Bid must be made on the forms in the Bid Submittal Document or exact copy with a price quoted for each item of work, the price of labor and materials to be stated where required. The sealed envelope containing the Bid must be submitted in accordance with Article 15 of the Instructions to Bidders.

The Contractor shall pay wages to the laborers and mechanics at a rate not less than the minimum specified on the current State of Ohio Wage Determinations, in compliance with applicable State Regulations.

This project is funded in part through the Ohio Public Works Commission. As such, the Contractor shall comply with the equal employment opportunity requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9.

The City of Tipp City reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals; to waive any informality or irregularity in the bids received or to accept any proposal for any style of tank that is deemed most favorable to the City of Tipp City at the time and under the stipulations in the Instruction to Bidders.
