2015 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project City of Tipp City

Sealed bids for the City of Tipp City's 2015 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project will be received at the Government Center, City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371 until 10:30 a.m. on Monday, July 13, 2015 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers.

The City's 2015 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project will consist of the following:

- Site 1: Approximately 1,500 linear feet of 8 inch water line, 1,000 linear feet of 8 inch sanitary line and 650 linear feet of 10 inch sanitary line.
- Site 3: Approximately 2,560 linear feet of 8 inch water line
- Site 1 & 3 Combined: Approximately 4,060 linear feet of 8 inch water line, 1,000 linear feet of 8 inch sanitary line and 650 linear feet of 10 inch sanitary line.
- Resurfacing of the affected roadways upon completion of the utility installations.

The City reserves the right to award the contract for this project to a single company for both Phases 1 & 3 or to award it as two separate contracts to different companies (one for Phase 1 and another for Phase 3) based upon which is determined to be in the best interest of the City.

Copies of plans and specification are available at the City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City Ohio 45371. The cost of each set of Contract Documents is **\$25.00** non-refundable.

The City intends to award this contract at the July 20, 2015 Council Meeting. All work is to be substantially completed prior to November 30, 2015 with the final completion no later than May 16, 2016.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

All items shall be quoted F.O.B. Tipp City, Ohio.

All bids shall be signed and include a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a contract with the City. A Bid Guaranty Bond shall be submitted in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the bid must be submitted, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid. All bidders shall

include a copy of the bidder's Workers Compensation Certificate and Certificate of Liability Insurance.

The City of Tipp City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in the bids, and to accept any bid which is deemed by the City to be in their best interest. No Bidder shall withdraw their bid within 60 days after the actual bid opening. Bid packages may be picked up at the Tipp City Government Offices, Office of the City Engineer, 260 South Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371.
