ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the Co. Rd. 25A and Kessler-Cowlesville Road Asphalt Resurfacing Project will be received by the City of Tipp City at the Tipp City Government Center, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371, until Friday, May 2, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. local time, at which time bids received will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the project consists of the asphalt resurfacing of Co. Rd. 25A from Donn Davis Way to Commerce Park Drive (5,190 feet) and Kessler-Cowlesville Road from the Tipp City corporation limits west of Peters Road east to Co. Rd. 25A (7,945 feet) including pavement planing, traffic sign upgrades, thermoplastic pavement markings, ADA handicap ramps, and a short water main extension, including a fire hydrant. Construction is to begin after July 1, 2014 and after approval from OPWC.

The Bidding Documents which include plans (11x17) and specifications may be examined and obtained at the issuing offices of the City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, OH 45371 and Choice One Engineering, 440 E. Hoewisher Road, Sidney, OH 45365 and cost \$25.00 and is non-refundable. Checks can be made payable to Choice One Engineering. Bidder must be Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) prequalified. The DBE goal for this project is 6%

Neither Owner nor Choice One will be responsible for full or partial sets of bidding documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than Choice One.

Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, sealed in a properly identified envelope.

Each Bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Bid and all persons interested therein. Each Bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed and ready for final payment no later than October 3, 2014. The project is scheduled to be awarded on May 19, 2014.

The bid security shall be furnished in accordance with Instructions to Bidders.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages. Attention of the Bidder is called to the various insurance requirements and various equal opportunity provisions.

Current Federal regulation (23 CFR 635.410) requires all Bidders for Federal or Federal-Aid contracts to submit Bids based upon using only domestic steel and iron products, makes the submission of Bids incorporating foreign steel and iron products, an option that the Bidder may exercise following specified procedures.

No Bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
