Obtaining Burn Permit

Persons wishing to have an open burn in Miami County must obtain a burning permit from the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency. Anyone who does not have a permit can be cited.

Terms & Conditions

- *Burn only in small piles, not larger than 5'x5'x5'.*
- *Burning hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.*
- *Maintain all fires in a nuisance-free fashion.*
- *Notify the Tipp City Fire Department just prior to burning.*
- *Only clean, dry wood may be burned.*
- *The permits are only good for 90 days from date issued.*
- *Remove asphalt shingle, trash, tires, furniture, mattresses and all other smoke producing materials.*
- *Permit must be on-site during burning.*
- *Fire extinguishing materials must be on -site at all times.*
- *Burn only when the wind is less than 12 MPH.*
- *Open burning on Ozone Action Days is prohibited.*
- *Other: Burn site must be at least 1,000 feet from the nearest neighboring residence.*

RAPCA must be notified of changes in scheduled start and completion dates of burn.
