

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City of Tipp City W. Dow Street Reconstruction – Phase 2

Sealed Bids for the W. Dow Street Reconstruction – Phase 2 will be received by the City of Tipp City at the Tipp City Government Center, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, OH 45371, until Friday, January 24, 2014 at 10:00 am, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the Work consists of the reconstruction of approximately 600 ft. of W. Dow Street from Rohrer Drive to S. Hyatt Street, including the grind and overlay of the Hyatt Street intersection. Construction consists of all new pavement, curbing, sidewalk, water services, sanitary sewer, and the installation of a new storm sewer system.

The Bidding Documents which include drawings and specifications may be examined and obtained at the office of Choice One Engineering, 440 E. Hoewisher Road, Sidney, OH 45365. Cost for the Bidding Documents is \$45.00 and includes a half-size set of plans. Full size plans (24"x36") are available for an additional \$25.00. Both are non-refundable.


Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, sealed in a properly identified envelope, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

No BIDDER shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
