



Tipp City Parks Department Equine Park Rules

- Animals permitted are horses, ponies, donkeys, and mules.
- Animal owners are solely responsible for the actions of their animals and are the responsibility of the handler to remain in control at all times.
- Don't use trails when they are wet and muddy.
- If passing a horse going in the same direction, call ahead to let them know you are approaching; pass on the left; don't pick up pace until safely passed riders are okay.
- Ride single file on adjacent road that has vehicular traffic and ride with the traffic.
- Manure handling rule is clean up at trail heads and parking locations.
- Leave no trace - pack out what you pack in. Pick up litter left by others.
- Tie only to hitch rails or trailers. Tying to trees is prohibited.
- Stay on trails.

- Beware of horses at all times. Don't make sudden movements. Hikers yield to horses.
