2014 Miami County Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off

The Miami County Sanitary Engineering will be holding a hazardous waste drop-off program the first Wednesday each month from 2 – 6 pm. Dates for 2014 events are June 4, July 2, August 6, September 3 and October 1. Cost is \$1/pound. They are located at 2200 North County Road 25A in Troy.

Items for proper disposal include: paint cans (latex and acrylic), aerosol cans of paint, strippers, pool chemicals, gasoline/kerosene, fluorescent light bulbs, household cleaners, antifreeze, varnishes and stains, wax/adhesives/sealants, pesticides, transmission fluid, mercury, turpentine and fertilizers.

Recent Storm Event

Tipp City staff is still operating in disaster recovery mode addressing health and safety issues. The Miami Conservancy District rain gauges show Tipp City received 5.5 inches of rain in less than 2 hours. The Ohio EPA informed city staff this was a 1,000 – 2,000 year storm event.

Residents can take limbs and yard waste to B&R Mulch at 620 Ginghamburg Road at no cost. Waste Management Inc. will also be picking up household storm items (carpet, padding, boxes, etc) without needing to call them. Waste Management has requested the resident limit their extra waste a 4' by 8' by 4' "pile" of storm related items. Items can be set out for the next several weeks. Tipp Monroe Community Services is working with several groups to help disadvantaged homeowners clean up their basements and have several hot water heaters. They can be reached at 667-8631. •

Yard Waste Disposal

Reminder... City residents have a new way to dispose of yard waste at no cost. The City has entered into an agreement with BR Mulch, 620 Ginghamburg Road, to accept City residents' yard waste at no cost to the resident. BR Mulch will accept yard waste in the form of branches, brush and trees (smaller than 12 inches in diameter). No leaves, stumps or root balls will be accepted.

Shelter Reservations

Whether you are looking for a place to hold a baby shower or graduation party, City Park and Kyle Park have shelters available for your special event. City Park features the historic Roundhouse and can seat 60 people. The Roundhouse can be rented for the entire day (7 am – 11 pm) to Tipp City residents for \$80. Also located in City Park are open air shelters which are available on a first-come, first-served basis and do not require a rental fee.

Kyle Park is the home to three shelters including the Rotary Pavilion, the Kyle Sports Pavilion and the Timmer Pavilion. The Rotary Pavilion is available at no cost on a first-come, first-served basis. Both the Kyle Sports Pavilion and the Timmer Pavilion rent to Tipp City residents for \$50 for the entire day (7 am – 11 pm). Both the Kyle Sports Pavilion and the Timmer Pavilion offer 8 picnic tables and a grill.
