2016 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project Site 1
City of Tipp City

Sealed bids for the City of Tipp City's **2016 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project Site 1** will be received at the Government Center, City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371 until 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, October 27, 2015 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers.

The City's 2016 Water & Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project Site 1 will consist of the following:

- Approximately 1,500 linear feet of 8 inch water line, 1,000 linear feet of 8 inch sanitary line and 650 linear feet of 10 inch sanitary line.
- Resurfacing of the affected roadways upon completion of the utility installations.

Copies of plans and specification are available at the City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City Ohio 45371. The cost of each set of Contract Documents is **\$ 25.00** non-refundable.

The City intends to award this contract at the March 7, 2016, Council Meeting. Construction is to begin March 21, 2016, and be substantially completed prior to August 18, 2016, (150 days) with the final completion no later than September 17, 2016 (180 days). Award of this project will be contingent on financing which should be available in February, 2016.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

All items shall be quoted F.O.B. Tipp City, Ohio.

All bids shall be signed and include a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a contract with the City. A Bid Guaranty Bond shall be submitted in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the bid must be submitted, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid. All bidders shall include a copy of the bidder's Workers Compensation Certificate and Certificate of Liability Insurance.

The City of Tipp City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in the bids, and to accept any bid which is deemed by the City to be in their best interest. All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for 180 days after the day of the Bid opening, but

Owner may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid Security prior to the end of this period.
