Substation #3 Power Control Room
City of Tipp City

Sealed bids for the City of Tipp City's Substation #3 Power Control Room will be received at the Government Center, City of Tipp City, 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371 until 2 pm on June 6th, 2016 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers.

The City's Substation #3 Power Control Room project is necessary for electrical load growth and system reliability. This Power Control Room will be added at the existing Substation #3 on existing property owned by the City.

The City intends to award this contract at the June 20th, 2016 Council Meeting. Power Control Room delivery is anticipated to be in 16 to 22 weeks.

All bids shall be signed and include a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a contract with the City. A Bid Guaranty Bond shall be submitted in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the bid must be submitted, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid. All bidders shall include a copy of the bidder's Workers Compensation Certificate and Certificate of Liability Insurance.

The City of Tipp City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in the bids, and to accept any bid which is deemed by the City to be in their best interest. No Bidder shall withdraw their bid within 60 days after the actual bid opening.
