
Tickets go on sale November 1 and are \$15 in advance, \$20 the day of the tour.

## Tax Facts – Did You Know???

The Tipp City income tax code requires all Tipp City residents age 18 and older to file an annual income tax return. Residents who are 16 or 17 years of age are also required to file if their income is not subject to Tipp City tax withholding by their employer, or if their income is subject to a municipal income tax at a rate less than 1.5 percent. Tipp City residents who are retired, permanently disabled, or have any other form of disability that keeps them from working, can be exempted from filing the annual return by completing a Certification Form. ## Tipp City Leaf Pickup Schedule for 2016

The Tipp City Street Dept. will be starting the leaf pickup program soon. There are a few important guidelines to follow. Residents are asked to rake leaves into the street, 1 foot from the curb, so that storm water will drain. **Please, NO limbs, sticks, bricks, rocks or yard debris should be placed with the leaves in the street.** These items cause damage to the equipment, create down time for repairs, and add delay to the leaf pickup schedule.

### Nov. 14 – Nov. 18

Areas throughout the City as needed. Areas between I-75 and N. Hyatt St. (north of W. Main St.) *No pickup on Veterans' Day, Nov. 11.*

### Nov. 21 – Nov. 25

All areas East of Hyatt St. (north and south of Main St.) *No pickup on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 24.*

### Nov. 28 – Dec. 2

Areas between I-75 and S. Hyatt St. (south of W. Main St.)

### Nov. 7 – Nov. 11 and Dec. 5 – Dec. 9

Areas West of I-75 (north and south of Main St.)

### Dec. 12 – Dec. 16

Clean up throughout the City as needed •

## Holiday Trash Pick-Up Schedule

Waste Management will not perform collection service on the following holidays:

- Thanksgiving Day – Thursday, November 24

Collection performed on or directly following a holiday will be delayed one day.

### Christmas trees will be picked up:

- January 2 and 9, 2017

Ensure all ornaments, icicles, garland and decorations are completely removed and place your tree curbside for pick-up. As an additional reminder, Waste Management will not collect trees if they are placed in plastic bags. •
