

Storm Water Pollution Solutions: Caring for Your Car

- To reduce pollutants on our streets, join a carpool, use public transportation, or ride your bike.
- Keep your car tuned up and regularly check your car for leaks.
- When changing fluids from your car, drain them into a clean container and seal completely. Take fluids and used oil filters to a household hazardous waste or used oil collection site.
- Never use a storm drain to dispose of any chemicals or other hazardous substances from a car.



Mosquito Fogging Dates

The City will be performing mosquito fogging applications throughout the City on the following dates:

- June 20 with rain date of June 22
- June 28 with rain date of June 29
- Aug. 30 with rain date of Aug. 31
- Sept. 12 with rain date of Sept. 13

The mosquito fogging will begin at 9 pm and will conclude by 3 am on the dates stated. Beginning on the western side of the City and proceeding easterly fogging the entire community.


Residents are advised to avoid direct contact with the fogging mist and to close home and automobile windows. If rain or wind conditions prevent fogging, the City will reschedule applications. Spring Reminders

The City of Tipp City Community & Economic Development Department wishes to remind residents that if they are planning to install a fence, deck, swimming pool, or accessory building (shed) in their yard or make an addition to their home, that a Zoning Compliance Permit is required prior to starting the project. Any other building/electrical/heating

permits needed are obtained at the Miami County Building Regulations in Troy. Please stop by the Government Center, 260 S. Garber Drive, call (937) 667-6305 or check our website www.tippcityohio.gov for further information when you are putting together your spring and summer building plans. Permit information on improvements to sidewalks, driveways, and approaches is also available. ●



Guidelines for a Recreational Fire

A recreational fire may be rekindled providing the following restrictions are adhered to:

1. The fire is not offensive or objectionable because of smoke or odor emissions or when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.
2. The wind velocity must be less than 10 MPH as indicated by the National Weather Service, and is in a direction to carry smoke away from neighbors. This can be monitored by TV channels 23 and 56.
3. The fire must be located a minimum of 25 feet from any structure. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
4. It must be fueled with clean dry firewood, natural gas or equivalent.
5. Fire extinguishing materials must be at site of burning at all times.
6. The fire shall be attended by a sober, responsible adult at all times.
7. The fire shall be extinguished immediately when the event is completed and/or the responsible adult is leaving the fire.
8. The fire shall be limited in size not larger than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height.
9. A recreational fire is one that is intended for cooking or enjoyment of those present.
10. Trash, yard debris, leaves or any other smoke producing materials shall not be burned. ●

Memorial Pavers

The City of Tipp City is currently accepting orders for Pet/Memorial Stones. Bricks will be installed in the Kyle Dog Park, but aren't just for dogs. Stones can be purchased for cats, fish, snakes, rabbits, hamsters, or any other beloved pet. The tan bricks are 6" x 6" and are available for \$20 per paver. Bricks may contain up to 3 lines of print, 20 characters per line, including spaces. Applications are available at the Tipp City Government Center, Tipp Monroe Community Services or online at www.tippcityohio.gov. Checks are to be made payable to the City of Tipp City.
