The tan bricks are available in two sizes: 4" x 8"- 3 lines of print (\$53.25) and the 8" x 8"- 6 lines of print (\$213.00). Applicants/honoree must have a connection to Tipp City/Monroe Township. Applications are available at the Tipp City Government Center, Tipp Monroe Community Services, or online at www.tippcityohio.gov. Checks are to be made payable to the City of Tipp City and received by September 1, 2019.

Guidelines for a Recreational Fire

A recreational fire may be rekindled providing the following restrictions are adhered to:

1. The fire is not offensive or objectionable because of smoke or odor emissions or when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.
2. The wind velocity must be less than 10 MPH as indicated by the National Weather Service, and is in a direction to carry smoke away from neighbors. This can be monitored by TV channels 23 and 56.

3. The fire must be located a minimum of 25 feet from any structure. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
4. It must be fueled with clean dry firewood, natural gas or equivalent.
5. Fire extinguishing materials must be at site of burning at all times.
6. The fire shall be attended by a sober, responsible adult at all times.
7. The fire shall be extinguished immediately when the event is completed and/or the responsible adult is leaving the fire.

8. The fire shall be limited in size not larger than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height.
9. A recreational fire is one that is intended for cooking or enjoyment of those present.
10. Trash, yard debris, leaves or any other smoke producing materials shall not be burned. ●

Fire Department Seeking Volunteers

The City of Tipp City Division of Fire is accepting applications for the position of volunteer firefighters. Proudly serving the citizens of Tipp City since 1874, you can become a part of this long standing department. Qualifications include completion of secondary education (high school diploma or GED equivalent) and a resident of the City of Tipp City or Monroe Township.

Duties of a Firefighter under direction of the Emergency Services Chief, will include but not limited to:

1. Responds to fire alarms and assists with controlling and extinguishing fires, operating trucks, aerial ladders, pumps, generators and other related equipment; utilizes gas and electric powered tools, hydraulic and pneumatic tools, ropes, and various other hand tools assisting in firefighting operations.
2. Performs various other forms of emergency assistance, rescue operations and calls for EMS assistance.
3. Maintains and updates records and reports as necessary and submit reports in a timely manner.
4. Perform routine upkeep of the station its contents and grounds.
5. Attends training/meetings as required.
6. Maintains required licensures and certifications such as CPR.
7. Demonstrates regular and predictable attendance.
8. Performs other related duties as assigned.
9. Drug screen and background check will be required. Work in inclement weather, on-call and non-traditional hours may be required.

Applications are available on the website at tippcityohio.gov and only handwritten applications will be accepted. Applications can be mailed or hand delivered to: Tipp City Government Center, 260 S. Garber Dr., Tipp City, OH 45371, Attn: Joanna Pittenger, Human Resources.

Applications may also be submitted in person at this location; Monday – Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Applications will close at 5 p.m. on Friday, August 30, 2019. Tipp City is an Equal Opportunity Employer. ●
