

ORDINANCE NO. 9 -19

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CODE SECTION 154.04(G)(42), AND MODIFYING CODE TABLE 154.04-5 AND CODE SECTION 154.14(B) OF THE TIPP CITY, OHIO CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FOOD TRUCKS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5-14, adopted March 17, 2014 established the Zoning Regulations of Tipp City, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Tipp City Council desires to establish a "Food Truck" Use within the corporate limits of the City of Tipp City; and

WHEREAS, "Food Trucks" are not listed as a Permitted or Special Use in the current Zoning Regulations; and

WHEREAS, on February 12th, 2019, the Tipp City Planning Board held a Study Session to discuss "Food Trucks"; and

WHEREAS, on March 12th, 2019 the Tipp City Planning Board held a Public Hearing, and did recommend the proposed enacting of Code Section 154.04(G)(42) and modification of Code Table 154.04-5 and Code Section 154.14(B) of the Tipp City, Ohio Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Tipp City Council desires to modify Code Table 154.04-5, Code Section 154.14(B), and enact Code Section 154.04(G)(42) of the Tipp City, Ohio Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIPP CITY HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances be amended as follows, with additions noted in underlined and deletions ~~struck through~~.

SECTION 2. §154.04: BASE ZONING DISTRICTS AND PRINCIPAL USES

(A)-(F) SAME

(G) Use-Specific Standards

(1)-(41) SAME

(42) Food Trucks

The following standards shall apply to any food truck:

(a) No person may operate a food truck in the City of Tipp City without a food truck permit issued by the City.

(i) Applications for a food truck permit shall be accompanied by a fee as established by City Council.

(b) The food truck vendor must obtain expressed written consent of the property owner to locate/operate a food truck on private property.

- (i) The written consent must be kept in the food truck at all times that the food truck is on the property.
- (c) Food trucks and vendor locations will be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition at all times.
 - (i) The food truck vendor is responsible for the proper disposal of waste and trash associated with operation.
 - (ii) Vendors will remove all waste and trash from their location at the end of each day and as needed to maintain cleanliness.
- (d) Electric, gas, and water will be self-contained within the food truck.
- (e) One Temporary Sidewalk Sign is permitted in accordance with Code § 154.11(K)(5).

SECTION 3. § 154.14: DEFINITIONS

(A) SAME

(B) Definitions

Food Truck

A kitchen within a licensed and operable motor vehicle or trailer whose method of operation is: temporary, in a transient location, and involves the preparation and sale of food and/or beverages in a ready-to-consume state for consumption either on or off the premises, but not within the motor vehicle.

SECTION 4. § 154.04-5 PRINCIPALLY PERMITTED USES

That Code Table 154.04-5 entitled "Principally Permitted Uses," attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is amended as noted in Section 1 above. All other Use Categories except for "Food Trucks" shall remain unchanged/"SAME."

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
