

City of Tipp City Seeking Public Comments On an Upcoming Project

The City of Tipp City is seeking public comments regarding the following project:

East Main Street Improvements, ODOT PID 103160 – The City of Tipp City proposes, through the use in part of federal-aid funds, to upgrade pedestrian facilities and infrastructure on State Route 571 (East Main Street), from First Street to Canal Lock Park and the Great Miami River Recreation Trail.

In general, the project consists of the reconstruction of East Main Street, including new sidewalks, brick pavers, street lights, and other streetscape amenities consistent with the corridor previously reconstructed between Fourth and First Streets. Improvements will also be made to the public utilities along the project route. The project is necessary to ensure all pavement, pedestrian facilities, and public utilities are up to current standards.

The City is hosting a Public Involvement Meeting in the Council Chambers of the City of Tipp City Government Center located at 260 S. Garber Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371. The public is invited to attend and provide comments on the project, the meeting will be held on Thursday, March 29, 2018 from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.
