



TIPP CITY ELECTRIC RECEIVES NATIONAL COMMENDATION FOR ELECTRIC RESTORATION EFFORTS IN FLORIDA & NEW YORK.

TIPP CITY, OHIO – September 5th, 2018— Tipp City Electric has received a national commendation from the American Public Power Association for its support in electric power restoration efforts in both Florida and New York.

In September of 2017, Tipp City Electric sent 4 linemen to assist Homestead, Florida which suffered widespread outages as a result of Hurricane Irma. These linemen spent 20 days restoring power to the residents and businesses of Homestead. In March of 2018, Tipp City Electric also sent a crew of 4 linemen to assist White Plains, New York in outage restoration efforts that resulted from the nor'easter winter storm that hit the east coast.
